



Make your own Quoits (Ring Toss) Game

Materials:

18 - 20 inch wooden stake or stick

60 inches of rope or heavy cord

craft tape (2 colors)

or

**ruler or measuring
tape**

scissors

masking tape & markers (2 colors)



To make the game:

1. **Cut rope or cord into four 15 inch pieces**



2. **Loop the individual pieces into a circle**



**3. Select two different colors of tape
or
use plain masking tape and 2 colors of markers**



4. Tape the ends together to complete a circle
***Note: Make sure to make two circles one color and two circles another color. That way each team has its own color**



Now that you have 4 rings, you are almost ready to play!

The last thing you will need is a stick to throw the rings onto

Find a strong stick or wooden stake

Ask a grown up to pound the wooden stick or wooden stake into the ground using a hammer.

To play the Game:

- Once the stick is firmly in the ground, decide on a starting line.
- Stand with your toes on the starting line when throwing the rings at the stick.
- Each team gets two rings of the same color.
- The players from each team take turns throwing their rings over the stick

To Score:

If you get your ring on the stick, then you score 2 points for your team

The first team to score 21 points wins!
